APPLICATION PROCESS:

Deliver your entries with completed information (see back of this prospectus) to:

Voting by entering artists and sponsors: 3 to 4 p.m.

This is a juried show. At least one piece from each artist is guaranteed entry into the competition and display in the show. Entering artists and sponsors will choose 13 artworks for the calendar, by ballot at the gallery, from 3 to 4 p.m. on intake day. SAG will provide refreshments. You must be present to vote, and we'll announce the results a bit after 4. To enter earlier than March 3, please email contact@sangresartguild.org to make arrangements. In case of inclement weather, alternative entry and voting dates are March 4 or 10.

Check sangresartguild.org on March 3 for confirmation of entry date.

ENTRY FEE: \$8 per piece for SAG members

\$16 per piece for non-members

CRITERIA:

- Each artist may enter as many as **three** (3) artworks. The calendar will include no more than one work per artist. The show will include for sale one to three works from each entering artist.*
- Each piece is limited to 1,296 square inches, with no single dimension greater than 36 inches, as measured at the <u>outside of its frame</u>. Keep in mind the aspect ratio of the calendar is a horizontal 8.5 x 11 inches. To fit a good calendar design, the editor may crop the image of unusually sized artwork.
- Artists may enter any medium. The three categories are original 2D artwork, original photography and original 3D artwork.
- All artwork must be original (no reproductions) and created by the artist within the past three years.‡
- Artwork must be framed or mounted appropriately, protected for handling and must meet 3rd Street Gallery criteria. No sawtooth hangers! See sangresartquild.org/3rd-street-qallery/gallery-criteria for details.
- Artists must complete Gallery forms when submitting.
- All artwork submitted **must be for sale** by the Gallery during the entire show. *No exceptions; no early removals!* SAG's commission is 30 percent or 40 percent, depending on member status.
- Artwork must comply with the Theme.
- * SAG reserves the right to reject any artwork for any reason.
- ‡ Copyright reminder: All submissions must be original works. Artists must hold copyright to their submissions and have permission to reproduce any source materials.

THEME: "Open Spaces – Wild Places"

Submissions to the *Calendar Art Competition* can highlight anything related to the culture, environment, people, wildlife, scenery, etc. of our lives in Southern Colorado, preferably the Wet Mountain Valley. Subjects are practically unlimited!

AWARDS:

- Thirteen artworks chosen for the 2019 SAG Calendar.
- Two People's Choice Awards of \$50 each, presented at Artists' Reception.

Cash awards are independent of the 13 chosen calendar artworks.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all artists of all ages. SAG membership is not required.

All artists must have signed exhibition waivers with the Gallery. These will be available at the Gallery on the day of entry.

Entry into the show constitutes agreement by the artists to allow their artwork to be reproduced for publicity purposes and in the 2019 SAG Calendar.

ART SHOW AND SALE:

Artists' Reception 4 to 6 p.m. May 5, 2018. There will be a *Best Hat* contest, festive atmosphere, door prizes and virgin mint juleps to celebrate the Running of the Roses at the Kentucky Derby. To make this a special event, we encourage artists to attend and invite their clients.

Artwork will be professionally shown and offered for sale at 3rd Street Gallery from May 5 - 28, 2018. SAG will carefully store all submitted works at the Gallery from the time of submission until pick up – except for the chosen pieces that must be photographed for the calendar (see below).

PICK-UP:

Pick-up of unsold artworks is 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. May 27 and 28, 2018.

PHOTOGRAPHY:

SAG will photograph each original artwork during the week following the judging. We must remove works from frames for photography. SAG will contact artists to coordinate any required reframing, which is the artists' responsibility. Photographers with work selected for the calendar must submit photographic files and a printed 5x7 color proof (for color matching) during the week following the judging.


LIABILITY:
