All artwork must be ready for display. Rules and Regulations for the show are:

- All hanging pieces and framed artwork must be equipped with screw eyes or D-rings and appropriate wire, no frame clips or sawtooth hangers allowed.
- All wet media, photos, drawings, and pastels must be framed under glass or plexiglass, or finished with a protective surface (wax, polyurethane, varnish).
- Unframed hanging pieces must be gallery wrapped (no visible staples).
- All sculpture and free-standing pieces must be equipped for appropriate display.
- Maximum frame size including frame is 30x40 inches or equivalent area unless prior arrangements have been made with the Gallery Exhibit Chairperson.
- Entries are limited to four (4) per artist (unless otherwise posted).
- The Pueblo Art Guild reserves the right to refuse to exhibit any work not considered to be in good taste and which may be offensive to the general public.
- All entries must be the original work of the exhibiting artist.
- All artwork registered in any show must remain on exhibit for the duration of the show.
- A 25% commission is retained by the Pueblo Art Guild for any piece of artwork that is sold. The purchaser may remove the artwork on the date of the sale. Another piece of artwork may be submitted as a replacement by contacting the Gallery Exhibit Chairperson.
- All entries will be handled with care. Pueblo Art Guild is not responsible for loss or damage. The artist is responsible for insuring artwork.
- Artwork left longer than 90 days after check-out date becomes the property of the Pueblo Art Guild.

COVID 19 Gallery Management

ARTISTS: You will be preparing your registration form, attaching labels to your artwork (front and back) in your car. When ready, each artist will enter the gallery to pay the entry fee and one-by-one place artwork for display in the gallery.

Gallery crew members will receive entry fees and catalogue the entries. No public gathering will be allowed.
